GOAL – increasing trust to the government, promoting dialogue between citizens and local governments



LISP - LOCAL INITIATIVES SUPPORT PROGRAM

Up to ~ 45K USD per project

(small projects, mainly rural)

Budget: ~1.9 mln USD

START - 2017



PORT - TERRITORIAL DEVELOPMENT

Up to ~ 1,5 mln USD per project

(big infrastructure projects)

Budget: ~15 mln USD

START - 2018



YOUTH BUDGET

Up to ~ 45K USD per school

(improving budget literacy for school students of 9-11 grades)

Budget: ~5.7 mln USD

LOCAL INITIATIVES SUPPORT PROGRAM

PROGRAM START – 2017

GOAL:

 Promoting dialogue between citizens and local governments to solve basic social problems

FOCUS:

- Small and medium size municipalities, mainly rural
- Small projects (up to 45 K USD)
- Improvement of basic local level social infrastructure and territorial improvement

DESIGN FEATURES:

- Two-stage approach to project selection:
 - Nomination of project proposals in municipalities – based on citizens' voting
 - Competition between municipal proposals – based on a set of formal criteria (share of population supported the project, contribution to projects by population and business, etc.)

over 60% of municipal proposals voted by people are finally approved and financed

 Co-financing by population and business (cash and in-kind)



START - 2017

GOAL:

• Improving budget literacy for school students, capacity building and motivation for the participation in PB/IB projects

FOCUS:

- Budget literacy for school students of Sakhalin oblast (grades 9-11)
- Capacity building and motivation for the participation in PB/IB projects
- Civic engagement of school students

DESIGN FEATURES:

General procedures similar to PORT
 Nomination, discussion and selection of projects

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT (PORT)

START - 2018

FOCUS:

- Urban and sub-urban areas
- Big infrastructure projects (up to ~1.5 mln USD per project)

MIX OF LISP and CASCAIS PB MODELS

DESIGN FEATURES:

- Two-level public discussions:
 - 1. Preliminary meetings in communities (with direct participation of citizens)
 - 2. Final meetings of community delegates
- Region-wide online voting by population

Authentication through the official national platform for public services ('GosUslugi')


PROJECT TYPE – construction (or acquisition)
Reconstruction of municipal social infrastructure

IMPLEMENTATION PERIOD UP TO 2 YEARS as of the date of project adoption and financing decision

FINAL MEETINGS OF DELEGATES AT THE MUNICIPAL LEVEL




CONCLUSIONS:

✓ 2 project proposals per each municipality to be put up for voting at the general regional meeting











CHALLENGES AND PLANS FOR THE FUTURE

CHALLENGES

- Transparency and openness of voting procedure
- Involvement as many participants as possible (increase in population coverage)
- Online procedure of voting and authentication through the official national platform for public services
- Media campaign PORT project
- Implementation of the projects chosen by the citizens with high quality and within the time limits set by the rules of the PORT, Youth PB and LISP projects

PLANS

- Conducting trainings and other capacity building events for project participants on a regular basis
- Sociological survey of the population
- In the framework of Youth PB project,
 the upbringing of an active life
 position of the younger generation
- Popularization of the PB practices of the Sakhalin Region (PORT, Youth PB) in the Russian Federation and in the world
- Development of new PB models aimed at engaging special groups, including the disabled
